

## **Child Labor Eradication**

Gwalior city is the main city of Gwalior-Chambal division and represents the division on the political and social dimensions, city is still considered underdeveloped due to low gender ratio, low literacy rate among deprived community, high crime rate and poor social and economic condition of women. There are thousands of families living under BPL because of this huge number of children working as child labour in hazardous industries like Stone crushing, Carpet weaving, Rag picking, Bidi Rolling etc. huge number of children are also working in Automobile, Hotel-Dhaba and as Domestic help. An estimate suggest that about 25 to 30 thousand children are suffering

CID is a team of people who are very sensitive regarding the child labor issue and working to save children from being involve in

hazardous industries. CID work to eradicate child labour from city with the help of a set of innovative program to extirpate the issue from city.

Child labour is the reflection of retardation of the community, Illiteracy, unawareness, unemployment of parents, poverty and migration from urban rural to are for together employment are responsible for magnifying child labour in city, to quash the effect of these issue on



children CID running a project MULTI SECTORAL APPROACHES TO ERADICATION OF CHILD LABOUR IN GWALIOR, which directly address these issue simultaneously towards the eradication of child labour.

To extinguish

the unawareness from the community, CID occasionally organized rallies, door to door visits, parent consultation meetings, parents training and orientation program, Adolescent orientation program, youth orientation program, Bal Panchayat and exhibition on regular basis and distribute literature based on child right, through this we will spread awareness. We have magnified the level of knowledge about the perils and hazards of child labor in community.

CID have also created Community Committee, a committee consist women of community. This committee carries the

responsibilities of upgrading the level of awareness of the community they coming from.

After elevating the level of awareness it's easy to remove children from work, after the removal of children from work CID groom the learning level of children along with their social, mental and physical development at its NFE centers.

**NFE Centers:** Non Formal Education centers are the center where we groom the children who earlier working as child labour .in these center we provide education to these children and elevate their learning level so that the can cope with the children getting education since start. Along with the education we also ensure that social, mental and physical development of these centre must take place.

- CID is running 9 NFE centers.
- Five Support and Remedial centers and four Child Development Centers
- Support center serving carpet weaving children and stone crushers area children with education, health, recreational support facilities.
- At Development centers children from Rag picker community are getting educational, health, social support as well as counseling is given to the children about consequences of drug addictions, health hazards and other subjects,
- Total 425 children are getting benefits from NFEs

#### SUPPORT AND REMEDIAL CENTRE

**Indira Nagar:-**There are 55 children registered at this center. The center runs in two shifts one for Child labour children engaged in Carpet weaving and other for school going children, among them 30 children (10boys and 20 girls) are child out of school and 25 (16 boys and 09girls) are school going children.

Shankarpur:-This Centre is for children involve in carpet weaving is running in Shankarpur. At this centre 30 children involve in carpet weaving (13 boys and 17girls) and 25 school going (6 boys and 19 girls). These children are getting education in two shifts.

### Naktapatha:-Naktapatha

centre belongs to charmer community, more than 70% people form the community are working at stone crushers. At this center, 30 child labour (16 boys and 14 girls) are getting non formal education (NFE) and behavior education



along with this 25 school going(13 boys and 13 girls) are also getting support education. These center runs in two shifts.

Kishanbagh:-There are 56 children are registered at this center, among them 39 children (9 boys and 30 girls) are working children and 25 (12 boys and 13 girls) are school going children. Children are imparted education in two shifts.

<u>Subhash Nagar:-</u>Subhash Nagar belong to a mostly minority community. More than 80% people work as laborer, all of these children are involved in Embroidery and carpet weaving work.30 working children (9 boys and 21 girls) are getting non formal education. 25 school going children (6 boys and 19 girls) all these children are imparted education in two shifts.

#### **DEVELOPMENT CENTRE**

**Noorganj:-**Noorganj is slums areas of the city which belong to butcher Muslim community, all children from the community involve in Rag packing. Total 35 children (19 boys and 16 girls) registered at this center are receiving Non formal education.

**Khajanchi Baba:-** At center of Khajanchi baba most of the children are Rag pickers. Majority of male members of community are daily wage worker some earn by playing music in marriages and other parties/ programs by their bands group and children used to go for Rag packing. During this reporting period 36 children (19 boys and 17 girls) are enrolled at the center.

<u>Transport Nagar:-</u> In Transport Nagar area there are workshops and shipment activities Rag Picking is regular and common in this area CID is running a development center to provide Non Formal Education to children who are involve in rag packing. There are 35 children (16 boys and 19girls) are enrolled at this center.

Madere Ki Mata:-Madere Ki Mata is slums area of the city which belong to lives 80 % Schedule cast. Most of children are Rag packers or out of school children. Most of male member of community earn by wages. All children from the community involve in Rag packing. Total 35 children (14 boys and 21 girls) are enrolled at the center.

NFE centre are the back bone of child labour eradication program and these center are also helping in elevating the education of deprived communities of the city.

## **Education**

CID believe **Education** is the basic ingredient of development process, education not only fillip the process of development but also give it a justly guidance which always steer a developing nation towards development. CID is working to lift the education of Gwalior up since it's embarked. To provide a Launchpad to education CID runs hyperactive campaign in the city. Every year, CID ignites **School Chalo Abhiyaan** with the wish of illuminating Gwalior by the light of education and to give wings to its aspiration of making Gwalior home of educated multitude.

During the current reportage span, we, The CID team organized 12 rallies across the city registered active participation 998 children .regular door-to-door visit done mobilize the **Exhibitions** community. invigorated the campaign. Exhibitions, Rallies and Door-to-



door visits covered most vulnerable are of city like Khajanchi Baba, Subhash Nagar, Mandre Ki Mata, Shankar Pur, Indra Nagar, Noorganj, Naktapatha, Transport Nagar and Kishan Bagh. This campaign yielded 378 enrollment from community and 60 enrollments from our Non Formal Education centers.

To support the elevation of education in city CID is working with NCLP and running a education and rehabilitation center for the children working in carpet weaving industry. In this education and rehabilitation center necessary education is being to the children along with professional training as well as nutrition food also being provided to children to ensure their proper physical development, since these children used to be the part of carpet industry and earning some sort of money therefor stipend 5rs per presence is being provide to the children which motivates them to be regular with school and also help to retain them.50 children are getting benefit of NCLP education and rehabilitation center. Cultural activities like BAL sabha, Painting Competition, Games are being organized on every Saturday to help children's mental development. NCLP also keep an eye on children health with regular health checkups.

Motive of CID is lifting up not only city's education level but also rural education to bring this motive into action CID is working

with **India Literacy Project**, currently covering 28 villages of **Vijaypur** block of **Sheopur** district of Madhya Pradesh, these 28 village are home of 3905 families 70% of them belong to Sahriya tribe.to lifting up the literacy level of these 28 village CID is working from the grass root level.CID team collect the



children data to identify the actual level of literacy among children of area and work according to circumstances.to mobilize community CID

1. Formation and activation of Village Education Committee, Mother committee

- 2. Regularize meetings of Village Education Committee, School Management Committee, Community, Mother Committee and Bal Panchayat
- 3. Orientation for all concern committees regarding the importance of child education and nutrition and child rights
- 4. Start Pre School education in Anganwadis, Training of Anganwadi workers and helpers.

CID have ensured 100% enrollment in Anganwadi centers in all 28 villages where children are getting preschool education and their health, nutrition level, growth is being monitored by CID. CID has regularized the distribution of nutrition food from Anganwadis which helped in declining the number of mal nourished children. Earlier Anganwadi used to open only for one day in a week for distribution of Nutritional food but now Anganwadi use to open for four to five days in a week

We consider, School is best place for children in order to develop and ensuring their bright future. Considering education as a dire need of present scenario, we are trying to enhance our step and day by day putting our whole effort to place our best shot for those who are deprived for essential needs for their development.

## **Advocacy**

In India, Childhood is caged in labour, trafficking, exploitation, early marriage and it needs a hand to bring them out of this cage and Child Line India Foundation offering this helping hand to children and In Gwalior city CID is working with CHILD LINE INDIA FOUNDATION to provide help to children. CID operating 24 hour Child Help line 1098 successfully and dedicated team of CID respond to call immediately and provide best possible help to the children in need .CID also organized Orientation program, Child group meetings, Rally, Human Chain, Signature campaign ,Drawing

competition, Rathyatra, Exhibitions to spread awareness and to mobilize community and to help children and mobilize children to protect themselves from the evils willing



se Dosti program a national level campaign facilitated by CID successfully and set of innovative program conducted to help children and to educate community.CID organizes Balloon flying program with children, Dosti corner, an

orientation program on Child rights, adopt a shelter home program, Signature campaign, Suraksha Bandhan program with Allied system, an exhibition and fun activities with children.

## Women EMPOWERMENT

India is the country where women are meant to be Devi however this golden notion can't be seen in material life particularly in communities which are rigid toward social and moral development and conservative in their thinking. Although women are significantly contributing in the development yet some men still have to raise their thinking above sex and domination. Women still have to live suffocating life while our space ship has tasted the soil of Mars. Somewhere nation couldn't build the protection shield for women which could save them from moral, emotional, social violence. Sensing the necessity CID stepped forward to protect women and raise them socially, economically and morally.

To resist the violence against women CID has formed "Mahila Hinsa Virodhi Samiti" a team of people who are sensitive towards women right and protection always available to help women in need.

Our society is built upon a thought which consider only men can be the bread and

butter earner of the family which resist women from going out and earn although women stepping forward are developing themselves economically at par to men backward however in community women are majorly depend on the men of the family for monetary concern, to nullify



this social deficit CID has come up with an innovative idea of "Self Help Group "

where women magnify their tiny savings by their mutual understanding and social intelligence.

A "Self Help Group "is a group of women who are belongs to economically backward society labeled as "Below Poverty Line "families . In these groups women accumulate their tiny savings and loan is provided to the members for their monetary needs .CID provide various social and health related training to these groups for their overall development .SHG has not only helped women in their economic development but also raise their level of understanding and intelligence and women are taking their decision on their own .CID has also sensitize women on social, moral, Health and Sanitization and environmental related issues. Women of SHG has stepped up on various occasion to protect the environment, resolving their document and bank related issue, educate community regarding sanitization.

- 90 women has received loan from SHG.
- SHGs have strengthened the leadership skills of women.
- Through the loan received from SHGs women took a step towards economic development.



primarily on social development of women CID has Created "Community Committee" in a community committee consist mostly the women of socially backward community .CID provide training on various aspects of

social development. In these committees CID provide all the information about various Government Schemes running for the development of these communities and also advocate them to consume the benefit of these schemes. Member of our community committee are very aware about social issue and we have recorded active participation on events based on various social issues from these committee. Member of our community committee are wise enough to resolve their issue related to Ration card, Aadhar Card, Samagra ID and various document required and needed. Member of our CC input their efforts to help society as they volunteered the rescue of three children from work and also stand their toe and got resolve the Sewage drainage system issue in two slum areas of city.

CID is developing "women" on social and economic canvas because these women are in need of it because they dint get the platform they should have got in their adolescence, recognizing the deficit CID have created "Adolescent

## Girls Group" to

knowledge which could boost the development of girls and help them becoming a socially ,economically ,morally developed women who can create separation between good and bad and could take decision



on their own and lead herself towards a Happy and Healthy life. In Adolescent Girls Group,

CID provides education related to health, culture, society and also motivate them to take stand against social evil. Girls of our Adolescent girls group are very much aware about the biological changes going to occur in their body and know how to prevention infectious disease. In Madhya Pradesh Mortality of Mother while giving birth is high because of early marriage therefore we have focused to stop early marriage, our training programs have injected confidence in adolescent girls to raise their words against Child Marriage .Adolescent Girl Group stopped a child marriage in a village .In this early age girls of Adolescent Girls Group are very much sensitize about social issue, environment protection, Child rights and actively participated in events throughout the year .

CID is very much concerned for women developments and protection of their rights therefore we working for their development throughout their life cycle, we ensures social, educational, mental development of girls in our NFE centers then provide justly guidance to girls in their adolescence and ensure their overall development in SHGs and Community Committees.

CID also concerned for **Gender Equity** and always raise female so that they will come at par to men ,CID also practice gender equity in its own organization therefore substantial of our employees are women.

## Health

Once USA president John F. Kennedy said that, "Physical fitness is not only one of the most important keys to a healthy body; it is the basis of dynamic and creative intellectual activity."

The extract from his words is that health is not only a physical phenomenon but is also affect one's mental, social and intellectual development, a person with sound health will be more intellectual, creative and social then a person with poor health. Health care should be among primary dos of any person.

In India health is a

very important issue, Government focusing on it with National Health Mission, Health Industry Growing at the rate of 15% yet the circumstances reflects the poor health condition of community especially in remote rural areas .Infant mortality rate is as high as 46 per 1000 Child (0-4) mortality rate is 14.1 per 1000, Condition in Madhya Pradesh is more worse where infant mortality rate is 67 per 100 birth. Maternal Mortality rate is 212 (SRS 2012) .Despite the continuous effort we have not achieved 100% immunization for Vaccination Preventable Disease. Condition of children is more worse according to UNICEF 15.8% of children are severely underweight and Vitamin A supplementation has coverage only to 59% of children. Another main reason of low rural health is improper sanitation and impure water .UNICEF states that only 23.9% rural population have access to improved sanitation facilities while in urban area it is 56.7%.

Considering the current hazardous scenario

CID stepped up to contribute its part in making India healthier. CID is working in various different ways to protect and cure India against bunch of disease .CID mostly

working in more prone remote rural are to mobilize community for their health. CID is working in collaboration with **TATA EDUCATION TRUST AND ALLIED TRUST** to Promoting community action for primary health care focusing on safe motherhood,

adolescent and child health in Shivpuri district of Madhya Pradesh. CID focusing to educate community so that they will themselve come forward and act for their welfare. Most of the maternal and infant deaths occur in the state of Madhya Pradesh highly preventable are considering this The Government of India along with State



Government launched its flagship program popularly known as National Health Mission (NHM) with its clear mandate to provide quality and timely services to the rural population. To make any rural health program effective active community involvement should be higher in planning, implementation, management and monitoring of the program. In NHM, the lowest formal structure is Gram Swasth Sabha Gram Tadarth Samiti (GSSGTS) earlier known as Village Health & Sanitation Committee (VHSC). This Committee needs to be strengthened and their active involvement is needed at all stages of communization. To ensure active and effective community participation CID organizes training for GSSGTS also create Adolescent girls club, Community core committee.

Adolescent girls club created to spread awareness about health and sanitation among adolescent girls which have helped in improving the understanding level of adolescent girls. They were given training on deworming and IFA intake. These girls play many important roles in villages and keep poking families to consume these tablets as per ASHA's prescription.

Community group are formed to timely aware the formal village admin system like PRI from different locally health concern issue. These groups were counseled by our trainer during community meeting in village.

CID also created Community based Community based

Nutrition Rehabilitation Centre which is a revolutionary step towards prevention and cure of mal nourished children. CID benefitted 154 children CNRC from these villages through hand has been given supplementary nutrition as a form of high density diet 2 times a day. The fabulous progress was recorded in two month of implementation in children. Families of these children have also adopted the locally

available food pattern for their children. All children were out of state of severe

malnourishment. 58 children are referred NRC who to having serious state of malnutrition.

CID

team has achieved remarkable results with the dedicated efforts of its team and loud participation of adolescent girls



group and Community core committee. 188 communities nominated members of GSSGTS were trained. Community Meetings with 471 people were conducted. 2 orientation programs were organized for PRI members. There were over 112 PRI benefited. Target achieved. Over 3300 household were contacted during IPC

13 health camps were organized. 1090 people from interior located village were benefited. Health camps were organized as where requirement were felt. More focus was emphasized on VHND session.

5 Community based Nutrition Rehabilitation Centre were organized at five highly malnourished villages. There are got treatment from these centers. All children were out of severe malnourishment. 58 children were referred to NRC.ASHAs worker have been equipped with many medicine and tools. Even CID provided some other medicine and equipment which was not available in Aarogya Kendra in general. Our worker is ensuring availability of medicine by informing government.

At one end CID is working for the welfare of infant, women and adolescent health at the other end CID is working for the reduction of diarrhea through ORS and Zinc tablet. Diarrhea is caused by unhygienic foot and impure water, street foot culture make India more vulnerable in urban areas and in rural area unsystematic sewage system, practice of defecation in open are, using wood and Cole ashes and clay to clean hand after defecation make rural area perilously vulnerable. 225,000 deaths occur every year due to diarrhea .CID is working for the protection and prevention of diarrhea in the rural area of north of Madhya Pradesh as it is seeing most number of diarrhea cases particularly in Shivpuri, Sheopur, Bhind, Datia, Morena and Gwalior. Main objective of this program is to reduce the death toll which is being caused by diarrhea and reduce the number of occurrence of diarrhea cases by mobilizing mother and care person of children. To achieve this capacity building of FLWs is done by CID team member then identify the children suffering from diarrhea and dehydration and provide ORS and Zinc Tablet to cure. CID team ensures that every children of targeted area must get ORS and Zinc on time when needed for this ORS and Zinc stock check done on regular basis by CID team and also maintain the transparency in information to increase the effectiveness of the program. ## Community Development

Community is the group of people living together with common characteristics; Society is the group of communities living together with some common and some different characteristics along the demographic diversities of that place. Communities have developed with the time basis on the resource they have access to. Some communities are conceded as underdeveloped due to lack of necessary resources such as education. Most of these communities are tribes living in remote villages, Identifying the need of their social, mental, educational, economic and physical development CID has focused on these tribes and working for their welfare under the head of various welfare and development programs.

In vulnerable slums are of Gwalior, women were living deprived life, to welfare of these women CID has created SHG for the economic development and Community Committee for the social development and acquired very good result.

In Kolaras village, tribes mainly Sahriya tribe living a very underprivileged life and CID worked for their welfare through Freedom from Hunger and Fear to Spread awareness of land rights and ensure Sahriya tribals are rehabilitated and recompensed under the Forest Resources Act and empowering the Sahriya community for their right of food and livelihood, so that they could attain their food security by demanding their rights and entitlements. CID has strengthen SAJAG so that it can attain a individual identity and member of this group raise their voice against exploitation. CID also build capacity of CBOs like Jagrit Mahila Sangh and Mahila Hinsha Virodhi core group of SAJAG to address issues related to women rights. CID also disseminated the information regarding the legal provisions and government schemes at the grass root level through the Manavadhikar Kendras and Baladhikar Kendras.

- Under this project 60 core group have been formed in order to empower community having 480 members. •
- To ensure food security 100 percent pds cards have been ensured households. 100percent card have been within project area. •
- More 90% percent elder member of community members getting old age pension in covered villages.
- More than 800 malnourished children have been admitted in nutritional rehabilitation centers.
- 250 people got patta forest rights act. ·
- 220 PWDs got certificate. More than 120 PWDs are getting pension.
- 325 children were admitted in hostels.



## CID for The People

CID works for the people's welfare and is not limited to the program based activities as various education and awareness spreading activities are being organized by CID for the welfare of people of Gwalior.

- CID works for Specially Able Persons (Disable) .runs various program and various camping for PWDs to ensure their development and their participation in community . CID also participated in many activities which were formed by various organizations. CID's fellows visited at APD-Bangalore, Padhar Hospital-Baitul, Roshni-Gwalior, Narayan Seva Sansthan- Udaypur etc. to study different dimension of this critical issue
- CID celebrated 25 year of UNCRC as" Global Action Month-2014" in the month
  of November. This month is being celebrated worldwide with partner
  organizations and other allied organizations.
  - CID initiated the activities from 1st of November and so on. In the series of activities, CID organized various activities like exhibitions, awareness rally, community meeting, meeting with youth and adolescent group, awareness activity at schools and education centers, human chain and other creative activities like puppet show, play, Human Chain, Exhibitions, Rallies.
- Bal Panchayats: CID organizes BAL PANCHAYAT which is a platform for children where they can directly engage with adult duty bearers in order to prompt their attention and action on child related issues, Bal Panchayat also allow

children to deliver their thought upon the issue related to them as well as it develop leadership skills, confidence and persona among children. Total 155 Bal Panchayats organized By CID with 757 participation.

- **Teachers Training:** CID organizes teachers training to teach innovation and interactive way of teaching so that the standard of teaching lift up and effective teaching comes into practice.
